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What is the Arabic Benchmark Test (A.B.T)?


- In order to deliver the Arabic curriculum to students we follow the framework standard of Arabic as first language and an Additional language in the UAE.
- This assessment measures the four key language skills Reading,
 Listening, Writing and Speaking.
- The assessment is based on the Arabic framework for Arabs and Non Arabs which is approved By M O E.
- The assessment is based on Bloom's taxonomy and includes testing for all ability levels.
- There are four assessments during the year: the initial baseline assessment, Term 1 assessment Term 2 assessment and the final end of year assessment.
- Each student will have an individual report generated for them after each assessment. This data will be represented in chart form and will show analysis based on internal and external benchmarks.
- An overall school report will be generated based onattainment and progress for each year group and level.
- The assessment will be marked out of 100 and will consist of 4 stages:
 - Reading (Two reading comprehension with 15 questions)
 - Listening (Two audio recordings with 15 questions)
 - Writing (five questions for creative writing), the student will have the option to answer these questions online or by writing.
 - Speaking (five questions) the student will record their answers online.
- The multiple choice questions are marked automatically. All other questions are marked by two professional Arabic team teachers to ensure accurate marking and moderation.





Ranges of skills





















